About James C. Humes

James Humes was a White House speechwriter for Presidents Eisenhower, Nixon, Ford, Reagan, and George H. W. Bush. He assisted former President Ford in writing his memoirs, *A Time to Heal*, and is the author of more than 30 books, including his autobiography, *Confessions of a White House Ghost Writer*.

James Humes has two honorary doctoral degrees, earned his juris doctorate from George Washington University, served in the Pennsylvania House of Representatives and worked as a trial lawyer. He previously served on the faculty of the University of Pennsylvania and Colorado State University – Pueblo. Queen Elizabeth II decorated him for his biographies on Churchill and Shakespeare.

Currently, James Humes is a professor at the University of Colorado at Colorado Springs, as a resident scholar in the Center for the Study of Government and the Individual.
