

Resolutions may be discussed but may not be denied by the caucus. Resolutions that are turned in at the caucus must be typed. Otherwise, resolutions may only be submitted by email to resolutions@larimergop.org. To have the best chance of being understood and accepted by the resolutions committee, resolutions should be in the form:

"Whereas.....,

It is, therefore, resolved that the Larimer County Republican Party....."

All resolutions must be received by 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 6, 2008. Only eligible participants actually attending a caucus may submit resolutions. Resolutions must include the full legal name, address and precinct number of the submitter.

The Resolutions Committee will host a meeting held at 7:00 p.m. on Wednesday, February 20th at the Pulliam Community Building, 545 N. Cleveland Ave in Loveland to discuss resolutions. Only resolutions submitted by the deadline will be discussed. The Resolutions Committee has final say on all issues regarding resolutions. All who attend are welcome to speak concerning resolutions. No new resolutions will be accepted. Only resolutions submitted through the precinct caucuses or by caucus attendees will be discussed.
